PLEASE NOTE THAT WATER IS A VERY SCARE COMMODITY:

The water is sourced from boreholes near the Spitzkoppe River on the south side of the mountain and is initially classified as unfit for human consumption. Therefore, it undergoes purification by our own reverse osmosis plant before being pumped to the Lodge.
All tap water at the lodge is potable.



IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- **Dinner** is served from 19:00 – 20:30 (special arrangement for children is possible).
- **Breakfast** is served from 7:30 – 9:30.
Breakfast packs are available for guests requiring an early departure.
Please arrange with your guide by 17:00.
- **Lunch** is served from 12:00 – 14:00.
Lunch packs are available on request.
Lunch packs must be ordered not later than 17:00 the afternoon prior to departure.
- **Check Out Time:** 10:00
- **Security:** Please lock all doors when you leave your room.
Valuables should be locked in the safe inside the cupboard.
Please keep your car locked.
- **Telephone Access & Emergency:** Please note that no landlines are available at the lodge, and cellphone reception is limited to certain areas. Alternatively connect your mobile device to the Wifi and use Whatsapp to make phone calls.
For optimal reception, switch to “2G only” under settings on your phone.

• **Laundry Service:** Available at an additional charge. Please leave your clothing in the laundry basket provided under the basins.

1. GUIDED SCENIC TOURS

2. MOUNTAIN HIKES & SCRAMBLES

Guided ascents of Spitzkoppe's granite peaks that require a good level of fitness and occasional use of hands, but no ropes.

Please choose your route carefully. Spitzkoppe's mountain routes are not ordinary hikes. Many involve steep rock scrambling, exposure to heights, and sections where hands are required for balance. Our guides reserve the right to refuse participation if a guest's fitness, footwear, or age makes the route unsafe.



3. WALKING TRAILS & SELF DRIVES

Explore the exclusive Spitzkoppen Lodge private reserve on peaceful self-guided walking trails through spectacular granite and desert landscapes.

2. MOUNTAIN HIKES & SCRAMBLES

3RD HIGHEST

Dufficulty: Moderate | ± 2 hours
Exclusive to Spitzkoppen Lodge guests.

A guided climb of Spitzkoppe's third-highest mountain, offering a rewarding mountain experience without the demands of the longer routes.

PONTOK (ON REQUEST)

Difficulty: Fit | ± 4.5 hours
No children under 8 years old

Fair level of fitness required as the first 50m is a steep climb. Loose gravel and rocks create slippery areas and the final climb is very steep again.

GROSS SPITZKOPPE (ON REQUEST)

Difficulty: Very Fit | 6-7 hours
No children under 12 years old

A challenging and exposed ascent reaching a high viewpoint near the summit. The route involves exposed scrambling and is suited to experienced, fit hikers and climbers. Recommended for highly experienced rock climbers.

- * Groups not exceeding 10

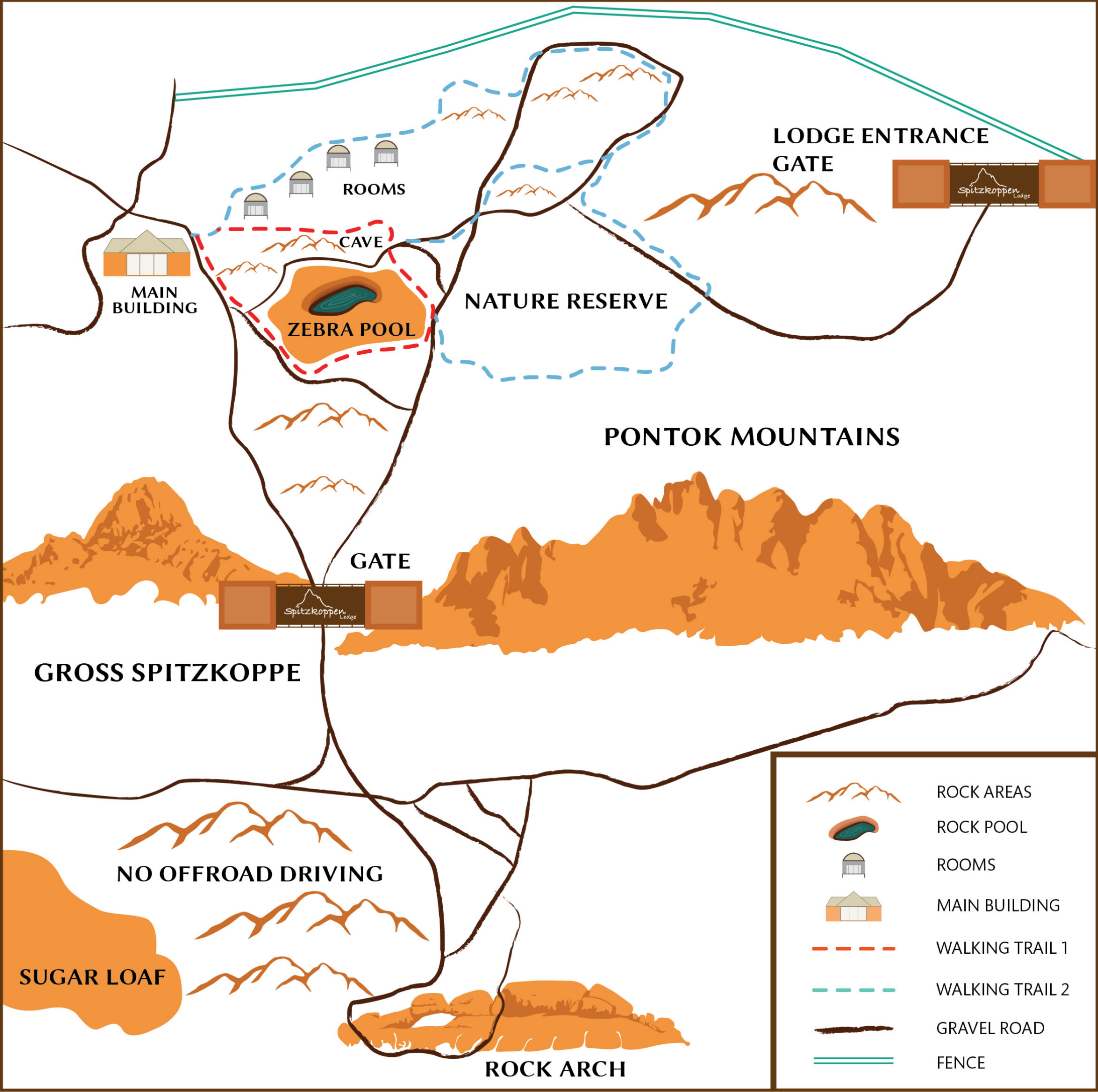
